I would like to inform everyone that we will begin the process of reviewing our Mobile Phone Policy. Currently, as it stands no student is allowed to bring a smart phone into school. There are many reasons for this policy, but the biggest is to help ensure the safety of all of our students, including online. As you are all aware, internet and social media access create huge problems. There is a danger that recordings of both staff and students are made and can subsequently be shared. (This is dealt with as a serious breach of our behavioural code and will be dealt with accordingly). We do however, acknowledge that parents/guardians need to be able to contact their children before/after school, especially when traveling to/from school on their own. Our priority as a school however is to ensure the safety of our students while in school and therefore we will look to review the current policy. We will welcome input from all of our school community.

I would remind everyone that there is a complete ban on smart watches and no student may wear one in school. There is internet connectivity and often camera access on them. Therefore we would remind everyone that they are to be left at home. We understand that many students got one for Christmas but again, please ensure that your child leaves it at home. If one is in school parents will be contacted

and reminded to leave it at home.
