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
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Seachtain Eolaíochta/ Science Week

COVID-19

Mar is eol do chách tá deireadh tagtha leis an rianú teagmhálacha ar scoil, rud atá théis dushlán ar leith a chothú do gach duine. Mar chuid de sin, tá cosc iomlán ar scoileanna eolas a roinnt maidir le cásanna dearfacha a tharlaíonn ar scoil. Roimhe sin, dhéanadh an HSE teagmháil leis an scoil agus scaipeadh eolas dá bharr. Ní chuirtear scoileanna ar an eolas níos mó fiú má tá cás dearfach i rang, ach amháin má bheartaíonn tuismitheoir an t-eolas sin a chur ar aghaidh chuig an scoil, rud nach gá dóibh. Iarraimid ar gach duine mar sin a bheith thar a bheith airdeallach maidir le comharthaí agus páistí a choinneáil sa bhaile agus teagmháil a dhéanamh leis an dochtúir/HSE má tá aon sort comharthaí ar pháistí. Mar is eol do chách, tá ráta na gcásanna an-ard sa sochaí faoi láthair agus tá thart ar 380 cás aimsithe i bpáistí 5-12 in aghaidh an lae faoi láthair.



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As we are all aware, contact tracing in schools ended a number of weeks ago. This has created a challenge for all school communities. Before contact tracing was discontinued, the HSE would contact a school in the case of a positive test, if they deemed contact tracing necessary (eg the child was in school in the run up to displaying symptoms). As a result, families were informed when a case happened in the class and could take appropriate precautions. However, since contact tracing stopped, schools are no longer informed (unless a parent informs the school - which they don't have to) and schools are not allowed to inform anyone of a case even if a parent informs the school of a positive case. We understand that this is causing some families a lot of concern but, unfortunately, we are not in a position to provide information of positive cases. We would, therefore, ask that everyone is as careful as possible and to not send children into school if they are displaying any symptoms of Covid (please see list below from HSE website). As we are all aware, community cases are very high at the moment with a rate of roughly 380 per day in children.

The most common symptoms of COVID-19 are:

- fever (high temperature - 38 degrees Celsius or above) - including having chills
- dry cough
- fatigue (tiredness)

Less common symptoms of COVID-19 include:

- loss or change to your sense of smell or taste – this could mean they're completely gone or just different to normal
- nasal congestion (runny or blocked nose)
- conjunctivitis (also known as red eyes)
- sore throat
- headache
- muscle or joint pain (aches and pains)
- different types of skin rash
- nausea or vomiting
- diarrhoea
- chills or dizziness

Symptoms of severe COVID-19 disease include:

- shortness of breath or breathing difficulties
- loss of appetite
- confusion



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- *pain or pressure in the chest*
- *[fever \(high temperature - 38 degrees Celsius or above\)](#)*

You may not have all of these symptoms or your symptoms may be mild. Symptoms may vary for different age groups or variants of the virus. It can take up to 14 days after you are infected for symptoms to show. You can spread COVID-19 during this time.

Symptoms of COVID-19 can be similar to symptoms of [cold](#), [flu](#) or [hay fever](#). If you are in doubt about any symptoms you have, phone your GP.

Club na Naíonán/After school club

Tá mé ag scríobh chugaibh chun uasdátú a thabhairt maidir leis an gclub agus suíomh an chlub don chéad thréimshe eile. Faraor, cuireadh moill ar cur isteach an tseomra réamhdhéanta toisc cúrsaí seachadta. Mar thoradh air sin, níl an halla ar fáil ar feadh thréimshe eile. Tá muid ag súil le go dtosóidh obair thalaimh an tseachtain seo chugainn, le réitiú don chur isteach. Go dtí go bhfuil sé sin déanta, beidh ar an gclub a bheith taobh amuigh, ach amháin má tá sé ag cur báistí idir 1.30-2.30. Má tá sé ag cur báistí, beidh an club ar siúl taobh istigh, ach, faraor, tá ganntanas spáis taobh istigh den scoil agus níl aon seomra ar fáil don chlub. I am writing to update parents on the current situation of the infant club. Unfortunately, there has been a delay in the installation of our proposed prefab due to delivery issues.
