

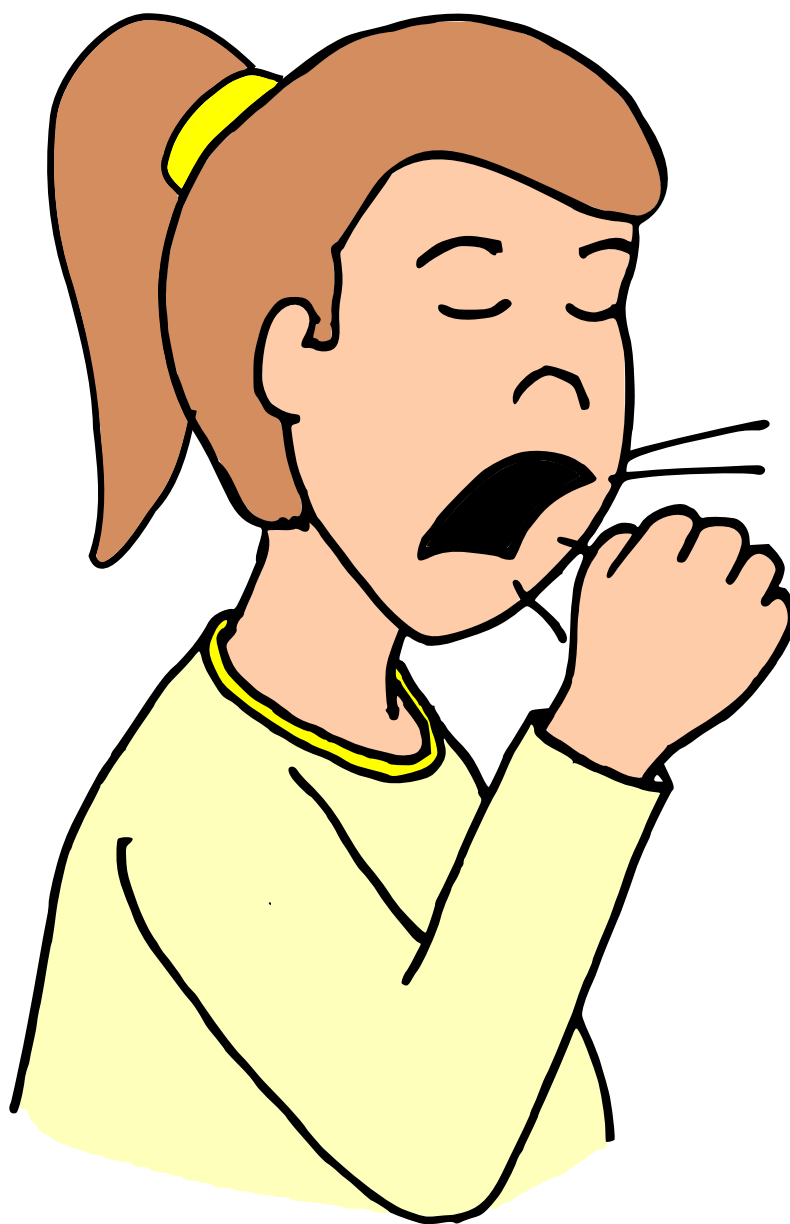

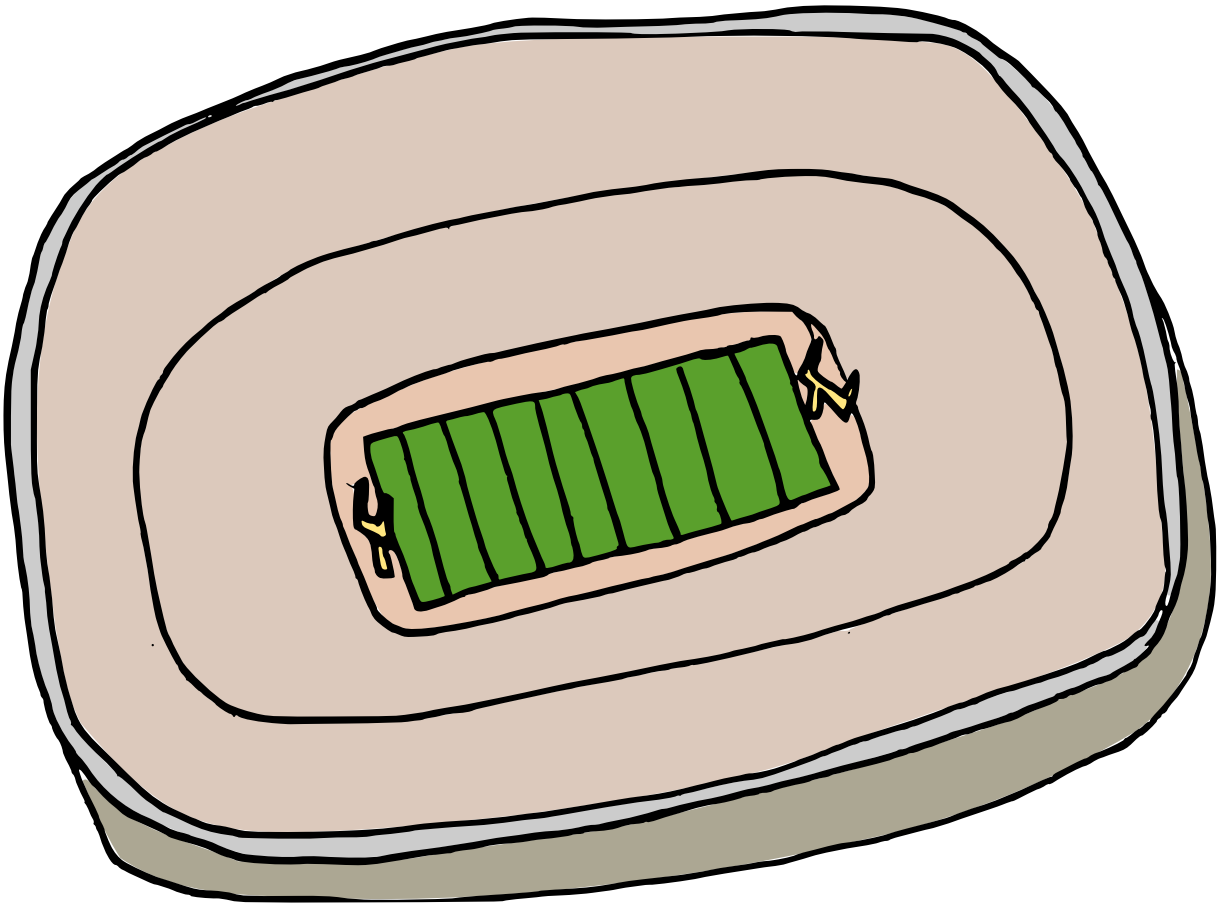
Getting ready to go to the Test  
Centre.



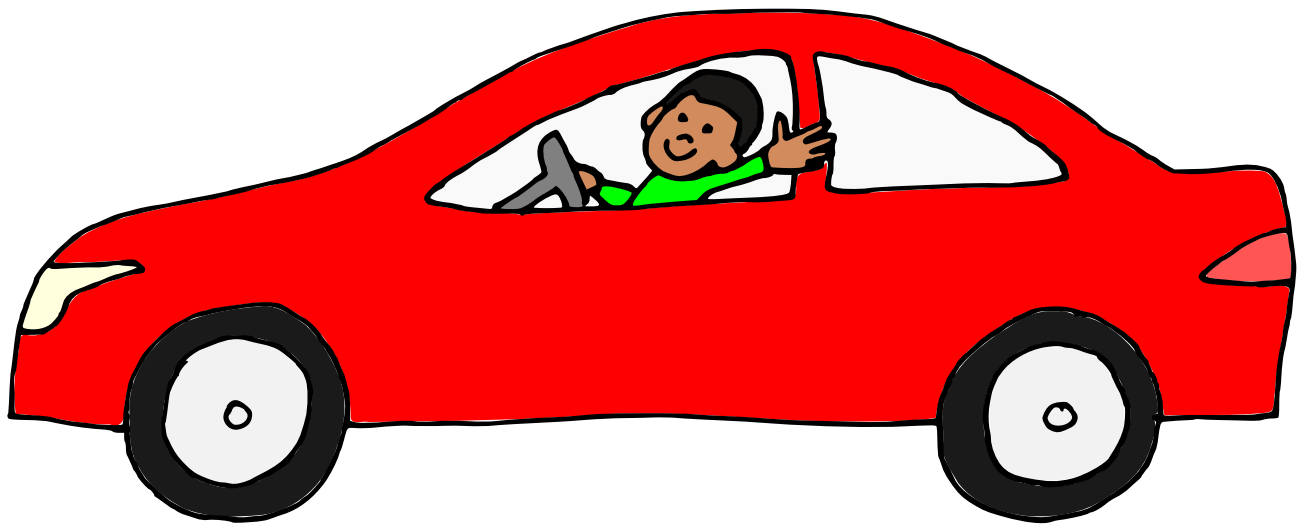
There is a new type of flu called the coronavirus. It's kind of like a cold.

checking everyone.



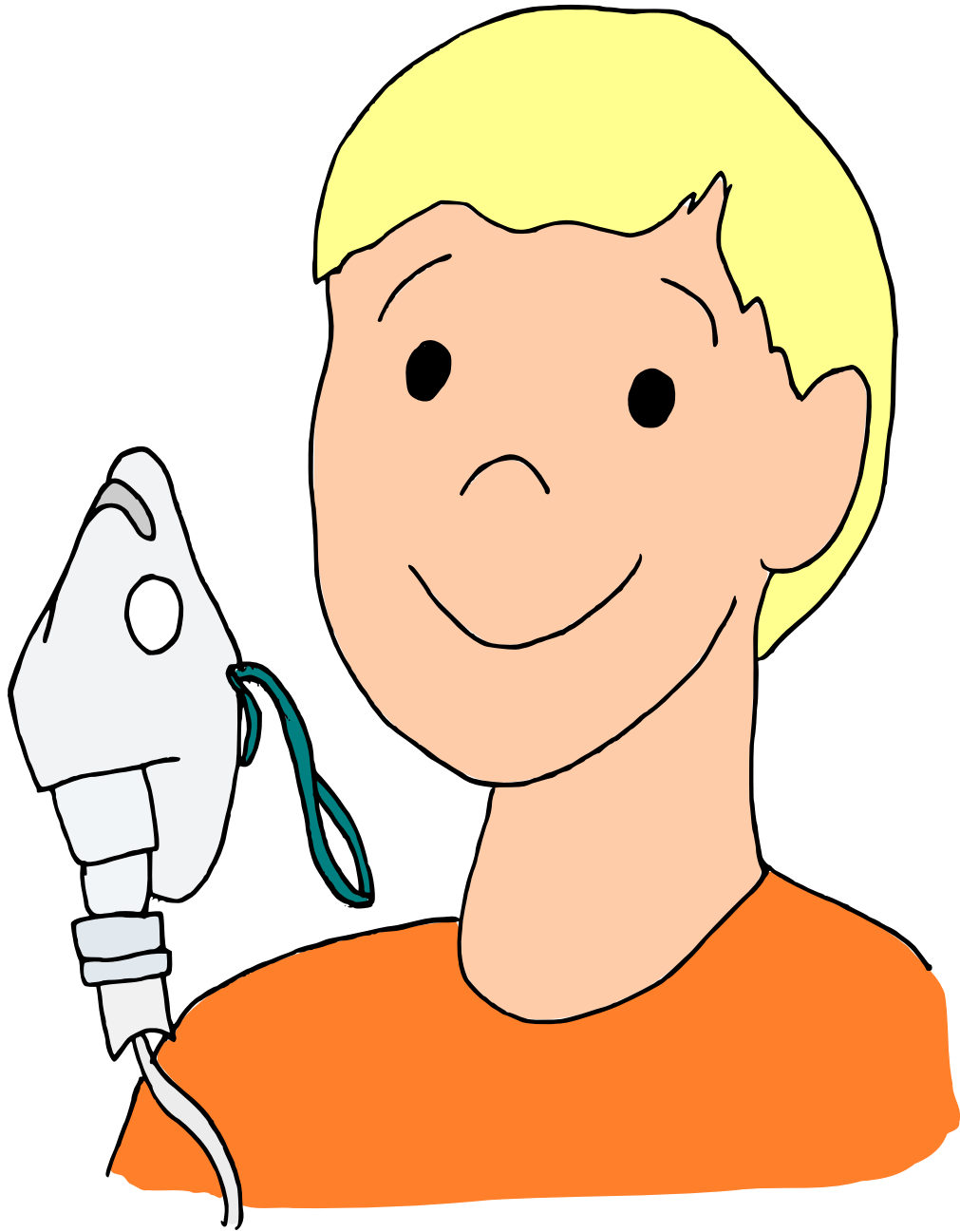
My Mam or Dad will drive me there.

The people we see at Croke Park will be wearing masks over their mouths.

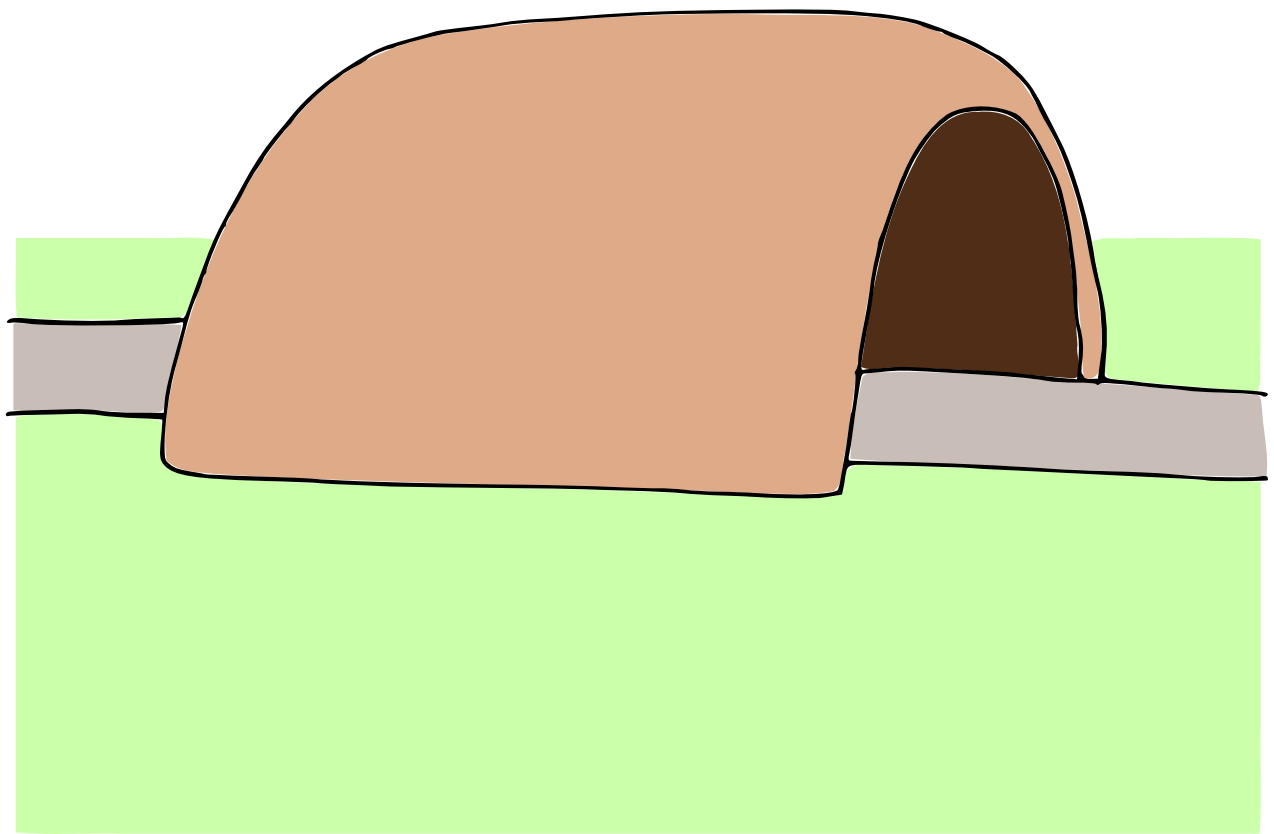


We will be given masks to wear too.

The nice nurses will wave hello and tell us where to stop our car. They look funny too.



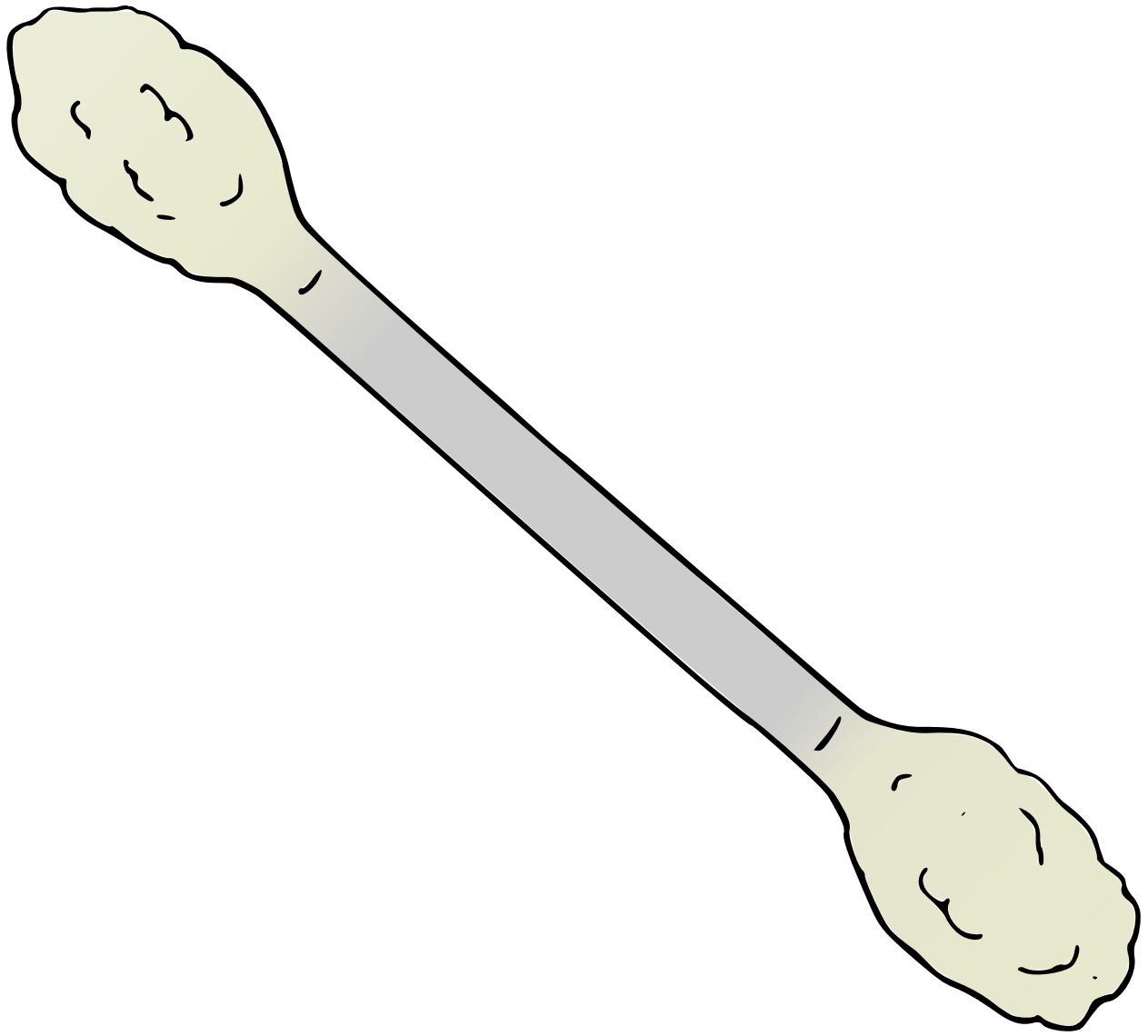
They are wearing big white sheets!

things to keep us safe.



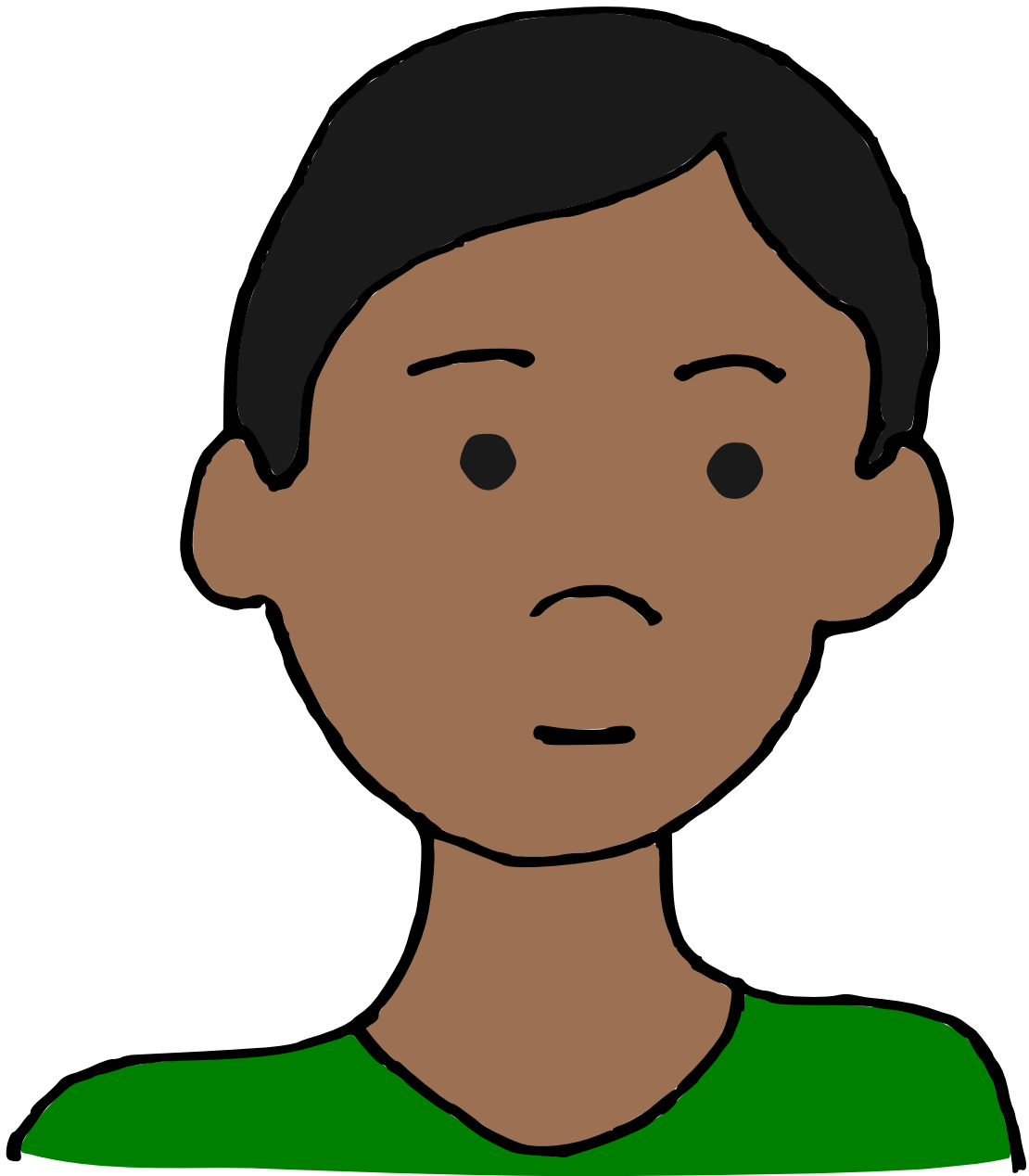
My mam or dad will roll down the window just a little bit to talk to one of the nurses.

nose into a tissue.

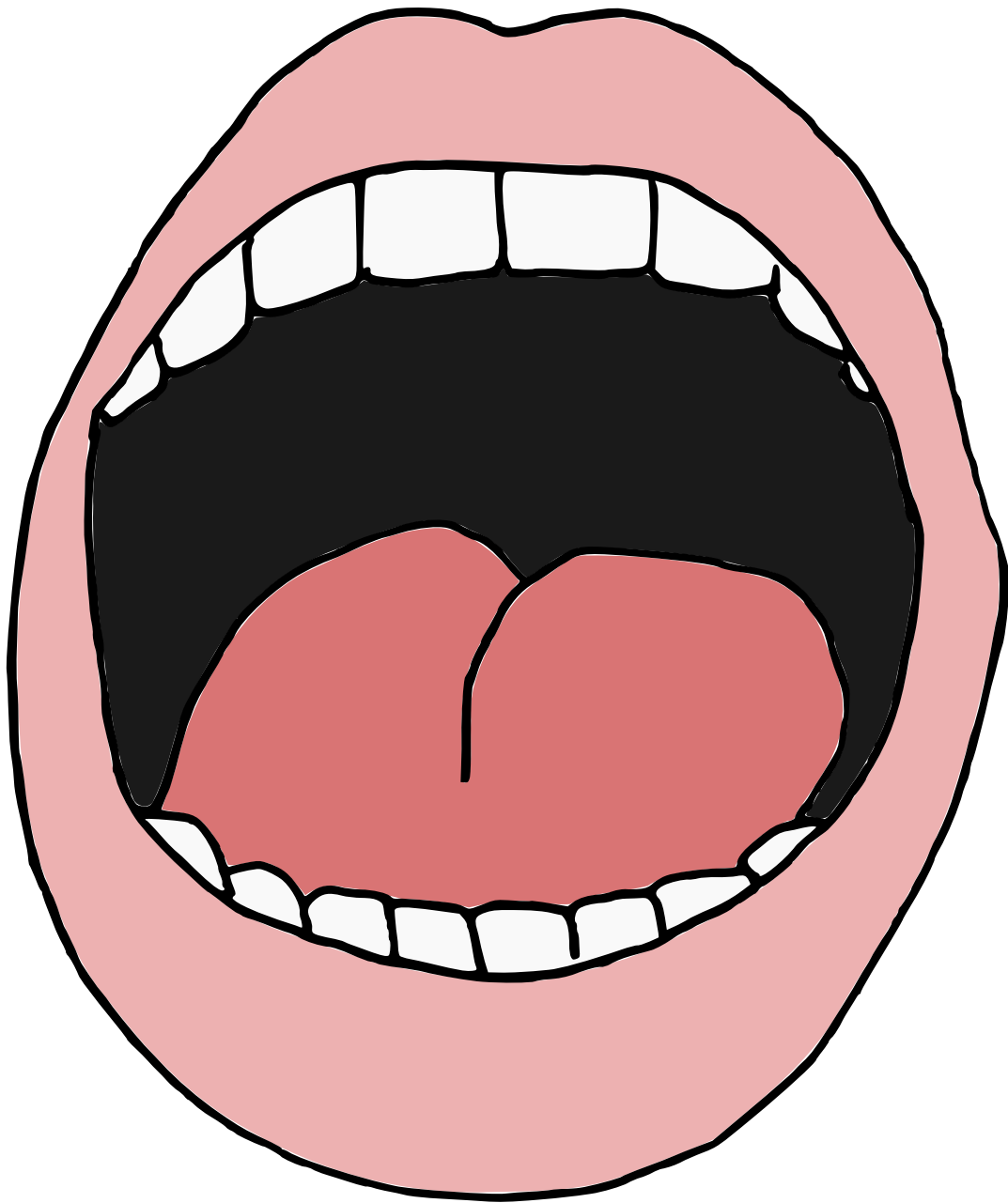


The other nurse will wipe the inside of my mouth and nose with a soft stick called a swab.
