### Fóin chliste/ Smart Phones

A chairde,

Tá mé ag teacht chugaibh maidir leis an bpolasaí fóin atá i bhfeidhm i nGaelscoil Bhaile Brigín agus maidir leis an gceist níos leithne i dtaobh úsáid fóin ag aosóg an lae inniú. Mar a thuigeann sibh, tá cosc iomlán ar aon chineál fón cliste a bheith i seilbh aon dalta ar scoil. Meabhraimid daoibh go n-áiríonn sé seo uaireadóir cliste chomh maith. Ba mhaith liom dul tríd réasúnaíocht an pholasaí seo le díreach meabhrú daoibh cén fáth go bhfuil an polasaí seo chomh tábhachtach don scoil. Ar dtús, ba mhaith an deis a thógáil a aithint an gá a d'fhéadfadh a bheith ann maidir le fón a bheith ag dalta agus sé sin má tá siad ag siúl abhaile agus go mbeadh teacht orthu. Chuige sin, tá fáilte roimh dhaltaí fóin a bheith acu nach bhfuil aon rochtán acu ar ceamara nó idirlíon. Tá baol caomhnaithe páistí i gceist le fóin le ceamra agus rochtán ar idirlíon. Tá sé tarlaithe ní amháin anseo ar scoil ach i go leor leor scoileanna fud fad na tíre go bhfuil pictiúir míoiriúnacha nó fiú díreach pictiúir tógtha ar scoil agus scaipthe go forleathan. Chomh maith leis sin tá baol ann maidir le taifead a dhéanamh ar bhaill na scoile gan cead. Is sárú rialacha na scoile an-mhór é seo agus bheadh impleachtaí móra ag baint leis seo an gcineál iompair seo, ag áireamh teagmháil leis na Gardaí más cuí.

Mar scoil, tá muid tiomanta maidir leis an eispearas foghlama is saibhre a chur ar fáil dár ndaltaí. Mar chuid de sin, tá muid ag tabhairt faoin bhfolláin go tréan thar an chéad chupla bliain eile mar go n-aithnímid an tábhacht seo mar chroílár dul chun cinn an uile duine.

Mar a thuigimid ar fad tá fás agus forbairt leanúnach ag tarlúint ó thaobh fóin chliste, cúrsaí idirlíne agus cúrsaí digiteacha go ginearálta. Aithnímid na buntáistí atá ag baint leis seo ar fad don sochaí, ach tá sé tábhachtach go dtugaimid aghaidh ar na baol chomh maith. Tá tionchar nach beag ag an rochtán leanúnach ar an idirlíon agus na meáin shoisialta ar shaol ár ndaltaí. Tuigimid chomh maith an brú ó phriaraí maidir le fóin a fháil ar aois níos óige agus níos óige. Tá an cheist seo á phlé againn mar fhoireann le tamall agus tá plé déanta chomh maith le Coiste na dTuistí. Mar a thuigeann sibh tá na cruinnithe ranga ag

tarlúint faoi láthair agus tá muid buíoch daoibh ar fad as bhur gcuid tacaíochta leo. Mar chuid dena seisiún seo tá ceist na bhfón á phlé - go háirithe ag leibhéal na meánranganna. Beidh moladh agus deis plé ann ag ranganna 2-4 ar an gceist seo maidir le conradh ranga a shocrú nach gceannófaí fóin go dtí go bhfuil daltaí an ranga sin ar aois ar leith. Tá eolas ag teacht chun solais go leanúnach ar an éifeacht a imríonn na meáin shoisialta ar fholláin agus ar mheabharshláinte an aosóig. Tá brú síoraí na meán sóisialta chomh maith le cibearbhulaíocht ag dul i bhfeidhm go láidir ar fholláin agus ar mheabharshláinte na hóige. Tríd aontú ranga i measc na dtuistí ar a leithead, chabhródh sé seo iad a chosaint óna leithead. Feicimid agus deir na daltaí iad féin go minic go mbíonn siad níos tapúla rudaí a rá ar líne nach ndearfaidís le haghaidh éinne. Bheifí ag súil le go gcabhródh sé seo caidrimh láidre i bpearsa a chothú agus a threisiú. Thabharfadh sé deis chomh maith eolas agus úsáid níos freagraí a leabú sna daltaí maidir le húsáid na meán srl roimh dóibh iad a fháil. Bheifí ag súil le go mbeadh tuiscint níos doimhne de réir mar a tá siad níos sinne ar na himpleachtaí a bhaineann le míúsáid a bhaint as meáin shóisialta agus go mbeadh roghanna cearta á dhéanamh i leith a gcuid úsáide.

Creidimid lena leithead de chur chuige ar bhonn ranga go dtugann sé tacaíocht do thuistí agus iad a iarraidh aois rochtán ar fhóin srl a chur siar tríd eolas a roinnt i measc na dtuistí go bhfuil tuistí eile ag cur siar aois rochtáin.

Tuigimid chomh maith nach cinneadh scoile é seo agus gur faoi tuismitheoirí atá sé cinneadh dá gcuid clann a dhéanamh ach bheimís ag súil tríd deis plé a chur ar fáil do thuistí go gcabhródh sé le muintín dhaoine an cinneadh sin a ghlacadh.

D'fháilteoimís go mór roimh aon ais eolas ar an gceist thábhachtach seo.

**I am writing to you all regarding our Mobile Phone policy in Gaelscoil Bhaile Brigín and to broach the wider question of phone usage amongst our young students today. As you are aware, all smart phones and/or camera phones are strictly forbidden in school. We would remind you that this includes smart watches or any other device which has a**

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camera or access to the internet. I would like to explain the rationale for this and remind you of the importance of this in our school. We do also, however, understand that some children may need access to a phone as they walk/get the bus home. We would remind parents/guardians that they are welcome to have a phone that has no camera or internet access in this situation. Under no circumstances however may it be turned on or taken out during the day in school. If this does happen, it will be taken and kept for the duration of the day. If this happens again, a parent or guardian will have to come and collect the phone from the office.

There is a Child Protection risk involved with children having access to phones with cameras or internet access while in school. It has happened, not only in our school, but in many many schools around the country, that inappropriate pictures, or indeed pictures of any type have been taken of other students (with or without their permission) and shared (again with sometimes, but often without permission) widely. There is also a danger that members of our school community may be recorded and again shared. This is a serious breach of school policy and will be dealt with through the code of discipline. This could have serious implications for any child partaking in such actions, up to and including contacting An Garda Síochána if necessary.

As a school we are committed to providing the best possible learning environment for our students. As part of this, we will be focusing on wellbeing throughout our school community over the coming years, in conjunction with the National Strategy which will be rolled out over the next while.

We are all aware of the continuous development and growth of smartphones, social media, and the ever evolving digital landscape. We all acknowledge and are grateful for the benefits of this for society, however it is important that we also recognise the potential dangers of the same. Continuous access to the internet and social media has a significant impact on young peoples' lives. We also appreciate that there

is constant peer pressure (not just from peers but from society in general) for people to get phones at younger and younger ages. As a staff, we have been discussing this issue for a while and we are witnessing the negative impact of social media and the constant accessibility of young people through phones and smart watches etc. We have also discussed this with the Parents' Committee.

As you are aware the class meetings are taking place currently and we are grateful for your support in these. As part of these sessions the subject of phones will be discussed; especially in 2nd-4th class. There will be a discussion around the idea of creating a contract amongst parents to push back, collectively, on the age of getting phones for children. This would also be discussed in classes with the children, highlighting the benefits. We know that there is more and more knowledge coming to the fore around the impact of social media on the mental health and wellbeing of young children. We see it here in school on a regular basis. The constant pressure from social media, in conjunction with cyberbullying is taking its toll on the mental wellbeing of our young students. We see and hear students themselves say things like that they would never say to someone's face comments that they would post on the likes of snapchat etc. We would hope that this initiative would help students strengthen their face to face communication. It would also give a chance to students to learn and be more responsible in their own usage of social media before getting a phone.

We also believe that this initiative will support parents who would like to push back the age at which their children get a mobile phone as there will be a collective support amongst parents in a class.

We acknowledge that this is not a school decision, rather it is a parents/guardians decision to make, however we would hope that this initiative will provide the opportunity for discussion amongst families around the use of phones at primary level. We would welcome any feedback that you may have around this issue.

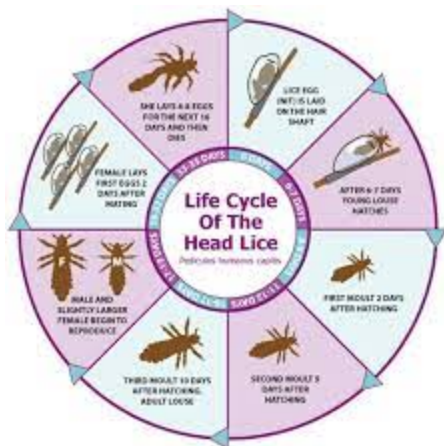
